# Flu vaccination for children from Reception to Year 5

The school nurses will be in school on **Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2018** to administer the nasal spray. Please ensure you return the immunisation form no later than **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018**.

Parents and carers are not required to be present during their child/ren's immunisation.

The vaccine is given as a single spray squirted up each nostril. Not only is it needle-free – a big advantage for children – the nasal spray is quick, painless, and works even better than the injected flu vaccine. The vaccine is absorbed very quickly. It will still work even if, after the vaccination, your child develops a runny nose, sneezes or blows their nose.



# Rainbow Theatre Workshop – Year 2

Year 2 are excited to have started their new topic all about our city and the Great Fire of London. The topic started off with a real bang when the children took part in a theatre workshop to re-enact the events of the great fire. There were opportunities to dress up, meet Samuel Pepys



and act out scenes from history. We learned lots of interesting facts about the fire and got to



experience the smells, sights and sounds of the event. There was even a smoke machine to create the smoky conditions of the fire! It ended on a real high when all children in the year group sang 'London's Burning' together.
