<p>Invent your own Olympic game. Write instructions on how to play the game and include a diagram that shows the steps involved.</p> <p>Include: imperative verbs, time connectives, bullet points to list equipment and an introduction to persuade people to play the game.</p>	<p>Magnet challenge: using a simple magnet (such as a fridge magnet), do a forces hunt around the house.
