We would like you to **complete at least two of the items listed in column 1** and as many of the tasks in column 2 as you would like to. All designing and written tasks can be completed in the children's home learning book. Have fun!

Write a letter from the point of view of an evacuee to your family back in London. Think about how you will convey feelings.	Design an Anderson shelter. Use a range of materials to make an Anderson shelter. You could include objects that would be in your emergency pack for when the air raid siren sounds.
Write a non-chronological report on an aspect of war that interests you.	Draw an evacuee.
You may wish to focus on the topic of: Women at war; Technology and weapons; Medical care; Childhood during the war. 	Sketch an evacuee who is having to leave London. You may want to include their suitcase. Think about their facial expression.
Write a newspaper report to announce that war has ended in 1945. You should research some historical information to make your report authentic.	Design a poster. Summarise key information relating to World War Two. Make your poster eye-catching.
