Our main focus for this half term will be developing children's ability to combine a range of reading skills in order to successfully answer a broad range of questions on a text. This will include learning linked to 'Horowitz Horror' by Anthony Horowitz.

Writing

In writing, we will focus on narrative writing. The children will write a range of pieces, including an introduction which captures the reader's interest, a description of a setting and an action sequence. Our focus will be on vocabulary choices and sentence structure.

Mathematics



Science
