#### Reading

There will be a big focus on comprehension this term and we will be doing lots of exciting activities to help us with this. Please remember to read every night, to build fluency, expression and understanding of a text.

#### Science

We will be learning about plants, which leads on from the work the children did in Year 1 on this topic. We will be classifying trees and plants and understanding the similarities and differences between them. In our classrooms we will also be growing a range of herbs and comparing their growth under different conditions.

#### Mathematics

This half term we will be focussing on:

- Place value and partitioning
- Calculation (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)
- Fractions of shapes, objects and numbers including corresponding notations

We will continue our daily practise of counting forwards and backwards from any given number in steps of 2,3, 5 and 10. This will support the children's understanding of times tables.
