Understanding the World

Our focus this half term is minibeasts. Each week we will be looking at different minibeasts starting with Butterflies and moths. We will be taking the children to Forster Park to take part in Forest School. Details to follow.

Literacy

As part of our topic this half term we will be listening to stories such as The Hungry Caterpillar and other stories related to our topic. We will also be looking at information books. In phonics we will continue to listen to and recognise different sounds in our environment. We will continue to introduce a different sound every week. The children will also be encouraged to form these letters using different methods e.g pen, finger in glitter, making the writing disappear. The children will also be encouraged to write their own name.

Maths

We will be learning about symmetry when looking at butterflies. We continue to order and recognise numbers to 20. We will be comparing length, weight and capacity.

Communication & Language

We will be learning Nursery rhymes and new songs about minibeasts. We will be learning vocabulary related to our topic. There will be lots of talk around our butterfly house. Watching them grow from caterpillars into beautiful butterflies.

Expressive and Creative Arts

We will be encouraging the children to make use of our wide range of artistic creations such as junk modelling. Painting symmetrical pictures of butterflies and making our own minibeast creations.
