Communication and Language

This half term we will continue working with our Speech and Language therapist to develop children's communication skills. The objectives we will be focusing on are: Sequencing, turn taking, following instructions and vocabulary development.

Mathematics

This half term we are continuing and extending our work on the following:

Reading and ordering numbers 1 to 100, looking and 2D and 3D shapes in our environment and measuring capacity. We will continue to link our learning to real life scenarios, e.g. how many plates do we need to set up the table, do we need "more or less" We will also be using outdoor equipment to develop

Understanding of the world

This half term our learning will be centred around the theme of 'People who help us'. We will be doing lots of fun learning around this topic including role play.

We will also be developing Technology skills in our ICT lessons, where children will be using 2Simple program to learn how to draw different pictures.
