

Reading

This half term we will begin our reading sessions by exploring poetry in depth. This will be followed by investigating our core text, using the skills of clarification, inference, summarising and predicting.

Writing

Pupils will be creating a report linked to their topic of Entertainment and Leisure in the 20th Century. We will also be writing stories based on the book *Leon and the Place Between*.

Mathematics

This half term children will be learning how to recognise, compare and order fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator. Children will investigate time, looking at days, months, minutes and hours. They will also look at analogue and digital clocks (PM, AM and the 24 hour clock).

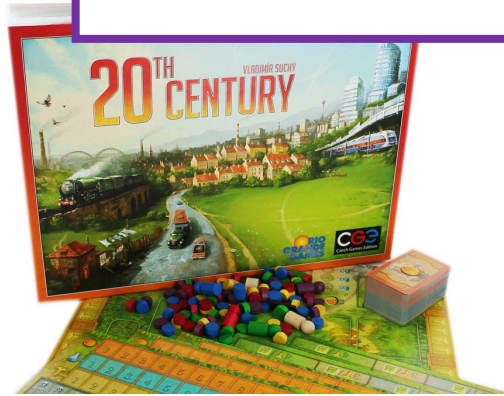
