As always, please come and speak to a member of the team if you have any questions, concerns or suggestions.



On Thursday 6th June, 10 children from years 5 & 6 represented Torridon Primary School at the annual Lewisham Quad Kids Tournament at Ladywell Arena.

Each child on the team participated in each of the 4 events - 75m, 600m, long jump and long throw.

Their efforts and passion were equally outstanding!

We had one child win her 600m race, four won their 75m sprints and all ten children recorded long distances in their throws and jumps. Out of the 20 schools who attended the event, Torridon came in 4th place!

To add to this fantastic achievement, Clio (6R) was awarded with a gold medal for being the highest scoring individual girl at the event!
