Year 1 will have P.E. on a Monday and Thursday.

Reading

Phonics will be on a daily basis this term and we will start our daily supported reading (DSR) this term also. Our main focus will be to recognise the first 40 high frequency words and also to be able to apply our phonics knowledge into our independent reading and building up fluency.

Writing

In writing, we will be experimenting with writing letters, labels, non-chronological reports and our own versions of the stories. We will also be focusing on using letter names to distinguish between alternative spellings of the same sound, applying simple spelling rules and forming capital letters.

Mathematics

This term in Maths we are going to focus on securing our knowledge of number to 20 and up to 100. We will look at simple addition and subtraction to twenty using real life problems, including money. We will also starting to have a go at explaining as well as justifying our answers.
