Greening Plans At Torridon

As you will have seen, we have a lovely laurel hedge that was planted last October in the playground along Torridon Road, thanks to all of your fundraising support. Friends of Torridon PTA, in partnership with the school, is continuing the greening project this autumn.

In November, we will receive 30 saplings from The Woodland Trust: a mix of dog rose, hawthorn, hazel, crab apple and dogwood trees, which will be planted along the Hazelbank Road side of the main playground, to continue our hedgerow.



The aim is to green up the playground environment for the children, bringing nature in, improving the overall atmosphere and air quality of the area, as well as creating a wildlife corridor around the school. The rich variety of trees from the Woodland Trust will give children and staff opportunities for outdoor learning - including helping with the planting! as well as encouraging birds and other small wildlife to make their home amongst the greenery.

We are currently in the process of applying for grant funding from The Mayor's Greener City Fund to continue that hedgerow around the ball court. There is also a plan in process through Street Trees for Living to have more trees planted around the outside of the school. They are all projects that will need the support of the whole school community.

The PTA looks forward to speaking to you more about it at the Play Out on Friday!

Playing Out

On **Friday 20th September** from 3.15pm to 5.00pm Torridon will be holding a whole school play out on Birkhall Road (between Hazelbank and Ardoch Roads)!

The road will be closed off to traffic (with stewards monitoring the road). It's a fantastic opportunity for families and children to come out and enjoy time together as a community. Please do bring bicycles, scooters, chalk, games and skipping ropes. There will be large games available like Connect Four and Snakes and Ladders, hula hoops and skipping ropes, as well as a big beach volleyball game. The PTA will be holding a cake sale with refreshments. Please note - no ball games are allowed on the road, but the big ball court at the school will be open for children to play ball games.

Parents and carers are invited to a coffee morning with Torridon Inclusion Team.




