This term in Maths we are going to be focusing on positional and directional vocabulary, fractions, measures and money. We will also continue to practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

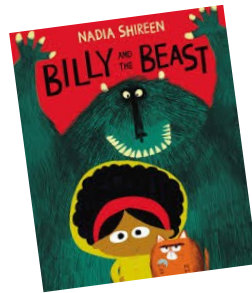
