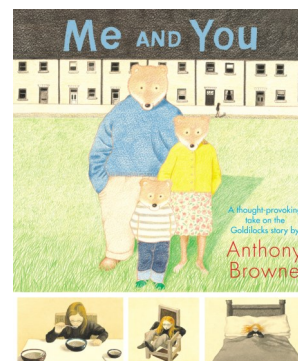
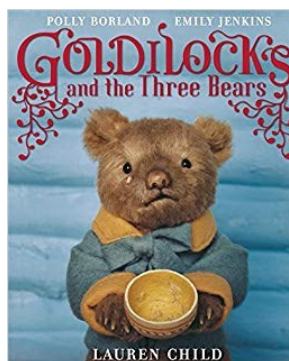
## Writing

## Mathematics

This term in Maths we will focus on securing our knowledge of numbers to 100 and beyond. We will be looking at solving multiplication and division problems, as well as exploring fractions. We will also be building on our knowledge of addition, subtraction, data handling and geometry.
