Free School Meal Vouchers

We are continuing to send Free School Meal Vouchers to eligible families every Friday. Thank you for your patience as I know there were some issues with the system this week. This week we will be using the new **Edenred** system as provided by the Department for Education. If you are having any difficulty accessing your vouchers, please contact a member of the admin team who will be very happy to help. Currently the government are only providing vouchers for families who have been approved for benefits related Free School Meals following an online application. If your child is in Reception or Key Stage One and was in receipt of Universal Free School Meals, vouchers will only be made available to you if you complete an application and meet the criteria set by the Department for Education. If you are unsure if you are eligible or are in need of vouchers, please do not hesitate to contact us and we will support wherever we can.
