Research the Viking Gods. Who did the Vikings believe in? Why?	Design and/or create a Viking Longboat.
Create a fact sheet all about the Viking Gods giving key information and interesting facts. Odin Odi	Make a Viking Longboat. What materials could you use? Can you make it float?
Viking Runes	Viking Sword and Helmet
Can you write the alphabet in Viking Runes? When you have done that write a message to a friend.	Make a Viking sword and helmet. They would have used these items when they conquered Britain.
Write a diary entry. Imagine you are a Viking soldier and you are sailing from Norway to Scotland on a Viking Longboat. It would have taken 2 days on choppy seas. Do some research to help with your diary entry.	Make a model of the human digestive system using things from your recycling bin (junk modelling). Label all the different parts.
