EYFS at Torridon

At Torridon, children are encouraged to be independent, resilient and responsible learners.

We help them to do this by setting up opportunities for learning in both our indoor and outside areas which are based on fun, engaging topics as well as children's needs and interests.

We follow the EYFS curriculum and hold learning through play and exploration in high regard.



Book Bags and Reading

Children will need to have their book bag in school every day in order for books to be shared at home. We will be hosting a Reading café every Friday morning in Nursery and Reception.

We use 'Letters and Sounds' to teach phonics which then links into their reading. This teaches the children about the sounds letters make before letter names.

- We are hoping to arrange stay and play dates for w.c. 1st September.
- We work as an EYFS team. Your children will be allocated into keyworker groups (Nursery) or Reception classes (Reception). These will be decided during the first couple of weeks in September.
- The first term will be focused around settling the children in and reinforcing the routine and structure of the school day.



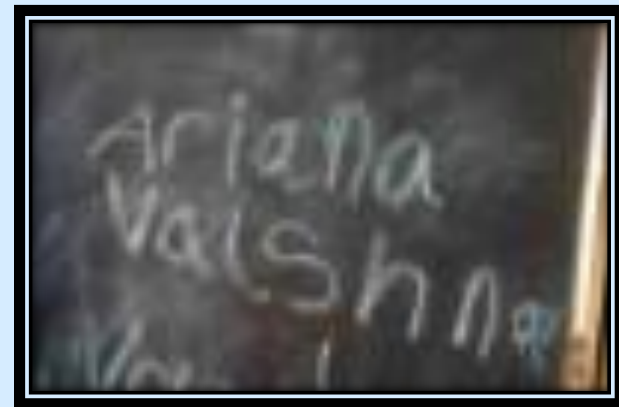
Getting Ready for September

Encourage your child to begin to be able to read their name when it is written down.

If your child is interested in writing and wants to, have a go at getting them to think about writing their own name, with a capital letter at the beginning and the rest lower case.

Share stories together and talk together about what is happening in the pictures and in the story.
