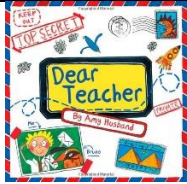


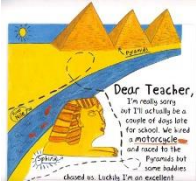

Tell your teacher about your first adventure. You can start with 'Dear Teacher'.






What will your next excuse be? Write a second letter to your new teacher to explain why you still can't return to school.
