Phonics will be on a daily basis this term. We will be learning to read a wider range of common exception words. We will also be developing our comprehension skills and exploring new vocabulary.

Writing

In writing, we will begin to develop our stamina through both fiction and non-fiction narratives. We will practice saying a sentence before we write it. We will also start to make simple additions, revisions and corrections to our writing.

Mathematics

We will focus on securing our knowledge of numbers to 100 and beyond. We will learn how to solve addition and subtraction problems using a variety of methods including partitioning. We will also develop our reasoning skills and learn how to justify our answers.

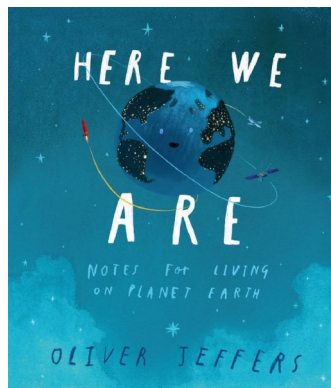
