We would like you to **complete at least two of the items listed in column 1** and then to choose some, or all, of the tasks in column 2. All designing and written tasks can be completed in the children's home learning book.

<p>Can you make a friendship poster? It is really important for us to look after one another and to be kind. How can you be a good friend? Make a poster to encourage people to be kind and a good friend to everyone.</p> 	<p>Make a globe: Can you make your own planet Earth? Have a go at labelling where we live and maybe even some other countries you know too!</p> 
<p>Can you write a letter? If you could have any pet in the world, what would it be? Write a letter to the pet shop telling them how you'll look after your lovely pet. You might give them the best cuddles in the world or you might promise to your pet Lion 5 times a day!</p>   	<p>Can you make a number line? Let's practise writing our numbers! Focus on the formation of your numbers and starting and finishing in the right place. Once you've done that, practise finding one more/one less than a number. Can you write the number sentence to match?</p> 
<p>Let's sketch: Sketch a picture of you and your family. You could even try to write a sentence about why you love them so much. Eg: I love my daddy because he is a super cook. I love my sister because she shares her toys with me etc.</p> 	<p>What do you want do when your older? If you could do anything in the world as your job, what would it be? An Astronaut? A Police Officer? A Ballerina? Draw yourself and have a go at labelling what you would like to be and why.</p>
