We had lots of fun making emotion wheels and bookmarks, writing poetry about our feelings, celebrating our difference and taking lots of photographs in our class 'photo booths'.

They will be available at playtimes and lunchtimes to listen, support and help children who may be finding things a little difficult. They will also have dedicated time each week to meet with identified children and work with them to help them feel happy at school and ready for learning. COVID-19 Case

As you know, we have had to close our Year 4 bubble this week due to a confirmed case of COVID-19. Thank you for all your words of support for the staff team and for your kind thoughts about the family of the individual who has tested positive.

As soon as the case was reported, we were in touch with the public health authorities and following a thorough risk assessment process, we were advised that anyone who had had contact with the individual who had a confirmed case would need to self-isolate for 14 days.

The staff and children from the year 4 bubble will be self-isolating until the end of next week and during that time we have closed the year 4 building to enable a thorough deep clean to take place.

The measures we have in place to minimise contact between individuals meant that we did not have to consider a wider school closure and were able to keep the self-isolation contained to just one bubble. Each bubble has an allocated playground zone and dedicated toilet facilities and the children stay in their year group spaces throughout the day. Currently only year 1 and year 6 are using the dining hall at different times and this space is cleaned between sittings.

The Year 4 team have been working very hard on the home learning for the Year 4 children and have been keeping in touch with them every day via Microsoft Teams.
