


This half term, our topic will be 'Looking after Ourselves and Each Other'. We will be focusing our learning around our core text, 'Here we are' by Oliver Jeffers.

<p>Can you write a diary entry?</p> <p>Imagine you are an alien from another planet, and you have just spent a week exploring Earth. Write a diary entry about all your wonderful experiences.</p>   	<p>Can you make a skeleton?</p> <p>In science this half term, we will be looking at human and animal skeletons! Have a go at making a human or animal skeleton. You could draw it, paint it or make a 3D model.</p>  
<p>Write a poem!</p> <p>Poetry is a lovely way to express our creative ideas. Write a poem describing Earth. You can make your poem interesting by using powerful adjectives and rhyming words.</p> 	<p>What are your hopes for the future?</p> <p>What do you hope will happen in your own life? What do you hope will happen in the world? Draw your hopes and have a go at adding labels.</p>
