Under the Sea:

Did you know that snow is really cold water? When it gets too hot, it melts back to water. Get some salt or sugar from your home and sprinkle it into a tray to make it look like snow. Have a go at mark making. Can you write your name?



Sinking and Floating:

Look in your garden or go out for a walk to the park and collect as many natural objects as you can find. Bring them home and experiment with sinking and floating in a bowl of water. Why do you think some objects float and some sink?
