<p>Suitcase must haves! If you were going on a seaside adventure, what would you pack in your suitcase and why? Draw and label what you would take with you and tell us why you have chosen those items. Don't forget to use finger spaces, capital letters and full stops in your writing.</p> 	<p>Make your own diorama: Can you create a 3D model of the seaside? Dioramas are a great way to create a wonderful setting so get creative!</p> 
<p>Can you make a tally chart? Make a tally chart and ask the people you know whether they recycle or not. You may want to add more categories by including if they recycle paper, plastic or food etc.</p> 	<p>Reusable shopping bags: Design your own reusable shopping bag to encourage people not to waste plastic bags. What material would you use for your bag? Think about which material would be most suitable and why...Metal? Glass? Wood? Plastic? Foil? Etc</p> 
<p>Can you research an endangered sea creature? Have a go at writing a fact file about your chosen endangered sea creature. Are they endangered due to being hunted? Are they endangered due to their habitat being polluted? Etc.</p> 	<p>Can you make a 'Save our Oceans' poster? Have a go at drawing/creating an underwater scene. You could even try and make it 3D and include some pop-up facts to encourage people to save our oceans and ensure they recycle.</p>
