Science

We will be comparing and grouping everyday materials based on evidence from fair tests including their hardness, solubility and thermal conductivity. Children will use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might separate, dissolve and evaporate, noting these changes of state are reversible.
