On Wednesday, we were advised by the Department for Education (DfE) that, in order to comply with COVID track and trace guidelines, the last teaching day of this term will be **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December.** Therefore, there will be <u>no school for children on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December.</u>

Children can be collected at the usual time on Thursday:

- 3.00pm Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 3, Year 5 and Resource Base
- 3.15pm Year 2, Year 4, Year 6 and siblings

Schools will still have a responsibility to assist with contact tracing until 23<sup>rd</sup> December. If any member of your household tests positive for COVID-19, you must notify us immediately so we can consult with the Public Health Team and inform any families if they need to self-isolate.
