This half term, the children will revisit all key reading skills. They will review how to predict, retrieve, infer and summarise. They will learn how to answer a range of comprehension questions. Children will also be given time each day to read for pleasure.

Writing

In writing, the children will be basing all of their extended pieces on the text 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin. They will produce biographies of the author, diary entries and letters. The children will also revisit a range of grammatical conventions.

Mathematics

This half term, the children will learn about fractions, decimals and percentages. They will learn to recognise equivalence and solve related reasoning questions. The children will also learn about the properties of shapes and angles in a geometry unit. Meet the Team!

Science

We will be studying forces this half term. The children will learn about how balanced and unbalanced forces impact on objects. They will learn how to conduct fair tests in order to explore how different forces can affect speed, direction or shape.

History

In history, the children will learn about The Windrush: they will look at where people came from, why and how diversity has shaped Britain. The children will have the opportunity to explore images and music linked to the topic.

PSHE

In PSHE, we shall focus on exploring British values. The children will learn about democracy and how it impacts the way we live in Britain. They will also explore the ethos of tolerance and respect for diversity of different cultures, faiths and opinions.

Dance


The children will explore forces and friction through dance duets to devise interesting and original ideas. Their choreography will link to their learning in science lessons.
