This half term, the children will revise all key reading skills. The children will review how to predict, retrieve, infer and summarise. They will learn how to answer a range of comprehension questions and will be given time during the week to read for pleasure.

Writing

In writing, the children will be reading 'The Great Kapok Tree' by Lynne Cherry . The children will write a range of text types including a poetry, narrative and a non-fiction survival guide They will continue to develop their use of verbs, adjectives and dialogue to help visualise characters, settings and to move the story on.

Mathematics

This half term, we will be developing our knowledge of statistics and data. The children will focus on understanding length and perimeter. We will end the half term by looking at fractions.



Year Three

Science

In science this half term, we will be studying plants. This will include dissecting a flower, planting seeds and observing growth, identifying the life cycle of a plant and exploring different methods of seed dispersal. The children will be able to identify what a plant needs to survive.

Geography

In Geography, year 3 will learn about rainforests. They will discover the equator, tropics of cancer and Capricorn, the climate and the consequences of deforestation. Year 3 will be able to locate a rainforest on a map and explain the layers that make it up.

PSHE

In PSHE lessons this half term, we will continue to focus on our core values.

We will also be exploring emotional regulation and how to help ourselves when dealing with intense emotion.

Year 3 will continue having P.E. on **Wednesday** and Dance on **Friday**. Children will need to come to school in their PE kits on Wednesdays.

In dance, this term we will explore "Stomp" - the musical production. We will use the body and ordinary objects such as brooms to create rhythms and dance.

Music


Year 3 will be continuing with their learning on the ukulele with a focus on playing longer songs that feature more and faster chord changes.


French
