

Reading

This half term, the children will revisit all key reading skills. They will review how to predict, retrieve, infer and summarise. They will learn how to answer a range of comprehension questions. Children will also be given time each day to read for pleasure.

Writing

In writing, the children will be basing all of their extended pieces on the text 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin. They will produce biographies of the author, diary entries and letters. The children will also revisit a range of grammatical conventions.

Mathematics

This half term, the children will consolidate their understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages. Children will also learn about the properties of shapes and angles. They will learn how to solve related reasoning questions linked to the geometry unit.

Year Five

Summer 1 2022

Science

We will be learning about growing and changing by exploring the changes that take place in humans. Children will explore the changes in humans as they develop over time - from a baby into old age - and learn about different aspects that indicate the stages in growth and development.

History

In history, the children will learn about The Windrush: they will look at where people came from, why and how diversity has shaped Britain. The children will have the opportunity to explore images and music linked to the topic.

PSHE

In PSHE, we shall focus on exploring British values. The children will learn about democracy and how it impacts the way we live in Britain. They will also explore the ethos of tolerance and respect for diversity of different cultures, faiths and opinions.

understanding of professional dance.


Music


Year 5 children will continue their journey on the steelpans with a focus on calypso music linked to the year groups topic on the "Windrush".
