







Year 4 Home Learning: Spring 2

This half term, our topic will be 'Earth Shattering Events'. We will be focusing our learning around our core text. We would like you to **complete at least two of the items listed in column 1** and then to choose some, or all, of the tasks in column 2. All written tasks can be submitted on Microsoft Teams, and practical tasks can be brought into school.

<p style="text-align: center;">Research</p> <p>Research information about an extreme event (volcano eruption, earthquake, tsunami) and create a fact file using your research.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Design</p> <p>Design an Earthquake proof building. Think about the fact that the building needs to stay standing although the ground is moving during the earthquake.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>Choose an extreme earth event, create a character who gets caught up and needs to escape. You can write a story or a series of diary entries.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Create a string telephone. Use this link to help you https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3yqB2KFwJCo Investigate if the length of string, types of string and size of cup effect the sound volume or pitch.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>A tsunami is a long, high wave caused by an earthquake out to sea. Create a piece of artwork which is inspired by the sea. Think about the tones and shades you would use to make your water look realistic. You can present your artwork in any way you choose—a sketch, painting or collage.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Use your mathematical vocabulary to create a Maths poster about Fractions, decimals and percentages. Make sure to show different representations of fractions and try and make links to division!</p>
