Add a list of well-known books he has written.</p> 	<p align="center">Book Review</p> <p>Michael Morpurgo has written many famous children's books. Read as many of them as you can and choose one that you enjoyed the most. Write a book review about it for the class giving your reasons and remember to make recommendations.</p> 
<p align="center">Scientist of the month</p> <p>Create a World War 2 telescope using a variety of materials. Decide the size and materials you can use for the lenses.</p> 	<p align="center">Evacuees</p> <p>Imagine what the evacuees must have felt when they had been told to pack and leave their homes. Think about the essential things they had to gather and take with them for the journey. Create a display or a 3D representation of what they might have had in their luggage.</p> 
<p align="center">Anderson Shelter</p> <p>Create your own Anderson shelter using the information about World War 2. Research key facts about the shelters and design your own one. Linked to our science topic about Materials, use a variety of media to add as much detail as possible.</p> 	<p align="center">Story Character</p> <p>Use your drawing techniques to create a picture of Joey or a scene from 'War Horse'. Feel free to choose your favourite media to design it adding as much detail as possible.</p>
