







Year 5 Home Learning: Spring 2

This half term, our topic will be 'All around the World'. We will be focusing our learning around our core text, 'Stories from Around the World'.

We would like you to **complete at least two of the items listed in column 1** and then to choose some, or all, of the tasks in column 2. All written tasks can be submitted on Microsoft Teams, and practical tasks can be brought into school.

<p><u>Write a folk tale.</u></p> <p>As we are reading stories from around the world, choose a particular culture and explore their traditional tales. Write your favourite one in your own words and tell us why you enjoyed it.</p> 	<p><u>Persuade us</u></p> <p>Write a persuasive letter to the government about the importance of taking more care of the environment and using less plastic.</p> 
<p><u>Scientist of the month</u></p> <p>Create a model of the solar system using recycling materials. Feel creative and use any media you can find. Challenge yourself and try to add moving parts.</p> 	<p><u>Conduct a research</u></p> <p>Research facts about the sun, earth and moon. Choose two planets to investigate them further and create a poster adding facts and diagrams.</p> 
<p><u>A call to all cartographers</u></p> <p>Use your mapping skills and create a map of our local community. Remember to add the key features of a map and to include the scales.</p> 	<p><u>Maths Poster</u></p> <p>Use your mathematical vocabulary to create a Maths poster about Fractions, decimals and percentages. Emphasise the links between them and show this using diagrams and pictures.</p>

Complete three Mathematics tasks set by your teacher for that week. Log in to your TTRS and practise as much as possible to improve your rock speed.
