
Tonight is our second 'pizza and cookie' night. Thank you to those who purchased kits. I hope you have fun making your goodies and that they are delicious!

Resource Base Reading Morning








We had a lovely reading morning in the Resource base on Thursday. It was lovely to see parents and carers coming in and sharing stories with the children. Thank you for coming to join us!




