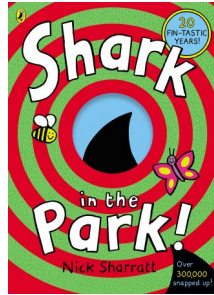




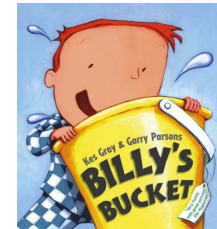
Deep Sea Detectives

The focus of this term is all about discovering and exploring the outside world. We will be using the stories 'Shark in the Park' and 'Billy's Bucket' alongside this topic.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This term, we will speak about changes and begin the preparation for the transition to year 1. We also continue to help children to develop a positive sense of self by setting goals, encouraging them to try their best, to persevere and opportunities to talk about their accomplishments.



Physical Development

Children will consolidate their handwriting skills daily writing of letter formation during class teaching and through independent free flow activities. The children will have the opportunity practise their physical skills through running, jumping throwing and catching, ready for any summer sports activities!



Communication & Language

The children will be encouraged to use more complex sentences when speaking and responding to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion. Children will be supported to use the correct tense when speaking. We will be exploring the vocabulary associated with under the sea .



Literacy

We will be learning rhyme through the story "Shark in the Park" and looking at creatures that live under the sea in 'Billy's Bucket'. This term we will continue with applying phonic knowledge through reading and writing simple sentences.



Maths

This term, we will continue to look at addition and subtraction using quantities and objects. We will look at the pattern of number including even and odd numbers. The children will solve problems involving doubling, halving and sharing. For instance sharing out toys or cutting up fruit!



Understanding the World

Our main focus this term is under the sea. The children will be learning about some creatures that live under or on the water . The children will continue to look at the growth and changes of different flowers and food we planted last term. Hopefully we will get to try some of our produce!



Expressive Arts & Design

The children will continue to explore different techniques and media. They will have the opportunity to make models and props linked to our underwater theme. Children will listen to music and make up movements that are associated with our underwater theme.
