Science

In Science we will again be doing much of our learning outside. We will continue to learn the names of common plants. We will learn about living things in our local area and observe and investigate a variety of habitats and micro-habitats, including the school grounds, the garden and the woods.

Geography

During this half term we will learning about the Yanomami people of the rainforest. We will learn about what rainforests are like, where they are, explore how the Yanomami people live and compare our location to that of the Yanomami.

PSHE

In PSHE lessons, we will be focusing on the unit 'Changing Me'. We will look closely at life cycles and what changes happen as well as develop an understanding of how our bodies have changed since we were a baby. PE

Year 2 will have PE on **Tuesdays** and **Dance** on **Thursdays**. Please ensure that your child comes in to school wearing their PE kit on these days. This half term we will be focusing on our athletic skills in PE.

Dance

In dance this term we will learn and develop dances from around the world using formations and patterns to develop our choreographic skills.



Music

In our Music lessons we will be continuing to learn how to play the recorder with a focus on learning more notes, improving our tone and playing different parts in an ensemble. We will also learn the position of the new notes on the stave.

RE

This half term, we will be using ScratchJr where we will use and modify designs to create our own quizzes and realise these designs in ScratchJr use blocks of code.

Art

In Art, all the children will be working with a variety of sculptural materials to create pieces of collaborative art focusing on body movements in Sport and Dance. The children will be learning about British artist Anthony Gormley.

DT

This half term, we will be exploring how strong a piece of paper is. We will be discovering that the strength and stability of paper can be increased by folding.
