Reading

This half term, the children will continue to revisit all key reading skills. They will focus on vocabulary, inference, prediction, explaining, retrieval and summarising (VIPERS). They will apply these skills during reading lessons and when they read for pleasure.

Writing

In writing, the children will be reviewing key writing and grammar skills. They will write a newspaper report based on the text: 'The Explorer' and a non-chronological report based on their class chosen Olympic country.

Mathematics

This half term, children will explore units of measurement for length, mass, capacity and volume. This will be learned practically, pictorially and through problem solving. They will convert between different metric units, using the prefixes 'milli and kilo'. Children will also continue to revisit the four operations.

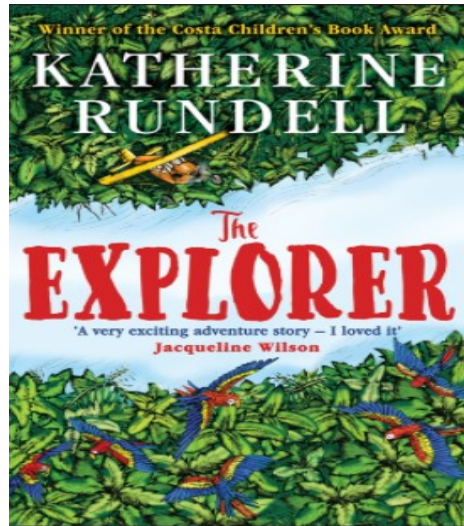

Science

In science, children will be working scientifically. They will be making predictions and conducting fair test and carry out an observation over a period of time to investigate what plants need to grow well. They will record their findings and draw conclusions.

Geography

Children will learn about fair trading, biomes and their eco-systems as well as human settlements. The children will investigate where food in the UK comes from. UK's largest exports.

RHE

In RHE, children will focus on relationships and health education. They will learn how and where to get help and support during puberty. The lessons will focus on exploring emotional changes that occur during puberty, how puberty affects the reproductive organs and the importance of personal hygiene.

PE

Year 5 will be learning football during PE sessions on a **Friday**. Their dance lessons will be on a **Thursday**. The children will need to come to school wearing their PE kits on both days. 5W will continue.

Dance

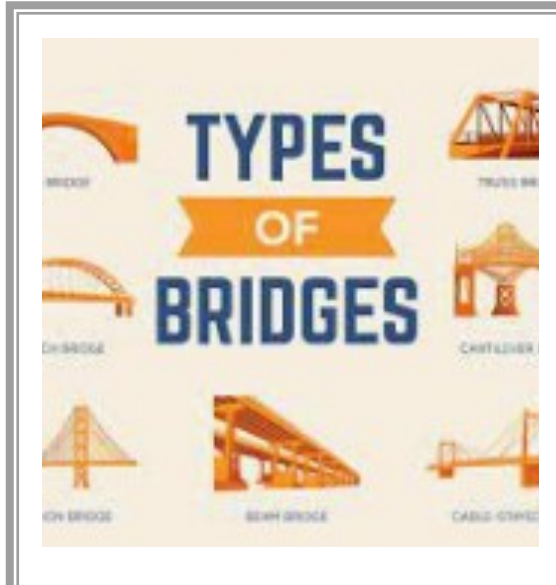

Music

Year 5 will be working towards their final performance on the steel pans. The focus will be on perfecting their own parts while playing sympathetically with other players.

French

The focus this half term is on home and community. As usual, we'll speak as much as possible and develop our language learning strategies alongside our knowledge of French.



Art

This term the children will be working with a variety of sculptural materials to create pieces of collaborative art. The children will be learning about the Guyanese artist Hew Locke and focusing on using fabric.

DT

This term, children will have the opportunity to research, plan and construct bridges, using various materials. They will evaluate their products and make recommendations.

RE

In RE lessons this half term, the children will focus on the teachings of Jesus and exploring the organisations that uphold Christian values.

Computing

In computing lessons, the children will use 'Scratch' to learn how conditions are used in selection. They will explore how a selection is used and will be identifying and modifying conditions in a programme.
