Writing

Science

In science, we will be focusing on evolution and inheritance. We will explore how living things have changed over time, what DNA is and what it does. We will also look at what evidence Darwin and Wallace share to argue their case for evolution and how animals adapt and evolve to suit their environment.

Geography

In geography, we will learn how to use four and six figure grid references. We will also explore what orienteering is and how to orientate a map. In addition, we will navigate a simple course using controls and set up our own orienteering course.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be focusing on the topic 'Changing me'. We will explain how girls' and boys' bodies change during puberty and become aware of the importance of a positive self-esteem. We will also focus on transition to secondary school.

ΡE

In PE this term, we will be focusing on match team games. We will play cricket, tennis and football. We will work on both our attacking and defending techniques. In addition, we will be working on our team building skills.

Dance

During the next term, all the children will be working with a variety of sculptural materials to create pieces of collaborative art focusing on body movements in sport and dance. The children will be learning about British artist Anthony Gormley and focusing on wire sculpture techniques.

Music

In Music, we will be learning songs for the Lion King, in preparation for our end of year performance of the Lion King. We will be learning songs as a class and a year group. There will also be some solos and duets.

French

In French, we will revise key topics covered throughout the year. We will continue to focus on sports and special occasions. Our key figure for this term is Jules Verne.



Art

During the next term all the children will be working with a variety of sculptural materials to create pieces of collaborative art focusing on body movements in sport and dance. The children will be learning about British artist Anthony Gormley and focusing on wire sculpture techniques.

DT

In DT, we will be designing and creating our own headdresses for the Lion King production. We will be using a range of materials and textures. We will then evaluate our products.
