



Reading

In reading this term, we will be focusing on key comprehension skills. We will explore new vocabulary, infer and make predictions about texts, as well as retrieve and summarise information from non-fiction and fiction books. We will continue to learn how to answer a range of questions linked to these texts.

Writing

In writing, our chosen book for this half term is 'War Horse' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be writing diary entries and letters in the role of characters from the story, biographies about our author and our own narratives based on the story.

Mathematics

PE Days


Children will come in dressed in their PE uniform on their PE days.
