






Our first texts will be:





Maths

- This term, we will be covering the following topics: place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, and fractions.
- We shall be learning how to add and subtract whole numbers as well as using the inverse operation to solve calculations. There will also be a focus on times tables.



Reading

During this half term, the children will focus on vocabulary, retrieval and inference questions. This will involve looking at different types of questions and answering questions based on our core text. They will also answer a range of comprehension questions, based on non-fiction extracts.

Writing

In writing, we will be creating a travel guide focusing on London. Within this unit, we will be focusing on forming simple, compound and complex sentences. We will familiarise ourselves with coordinating and subordinating conjunctions, as well as how to use a range of punctuation.

Science

As part of our science unit, we will be studying light. We will be exploring how light travels and how we see objects around us. We will be investigating sources of light and how light can move in different atmospheres. We will also be carrying out a range of practical scientific investigations.

History

This half term, we will be learning about how London has changed over time, with a focus on technology and transport. Our lessons will also enable us to develop key skills associated with historical enquiry. Our significant person this term is Lewis Howard Latimer.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be focusing on the theme 'Being me in my world'. We will begin by looking at the universal rights for all children. Then we will explore how our actions affect people locally ands globally. We will also make choices about our own behaviour and look at how an individual's behaviour can impact on a group.

PE

Year 6 will need their PE kits on **Thursdays** and **Fridays**. In PE, they will be learning the key skills of Hockey. Towards the end of the half term, there will be a PE tournament. They will also have dance lessons on a Thursday

Dance

In dance, the children will explore the links between technology and dance. They will explore computer commands and create duets inspired by the technology revolution.

Music

In music this half term, the children will learn how to play the ukulele. In addition, the children will be taking part in weekly singing assemblies.

French

In French, the children will be developing their understanding of talking to others. They will learn how to talk to someone new, where they will focus on how to ask and answer questions.









Art

This half term the children will be exploring the theme of community. We will also be looking at British artist Julian Opie and creating our own mixed media self-portraits.

DT

In DT lessons this half term, the children will be creating a steady hand game. They will develop their understanding of electrical systems and designs. They will be challenged with designing and creating a steady hand game.

RE

In RE lessons this half term, the children will learn about Buddhism. They will learn about Buddha's teaching and how the Buddha can be seen as the perfect person.

Computing

In computing lessons this half term, the children will learn about how to stay safe online. They will explore how to create a positive online reputation and learn how to manage passwords.

PE Days


Children will come in dressed in their PE uniform on their PE days.
