<p>Make an animal model Have fun using any recycling you have laying around, and turn it into a wonderful animal model. Get creative: we can't wait to see your animals!</p> 	<p>Diarama of a habitat Choose an animal, and have a go at making a diarama of its habitat. Think about what it will look like and what you will need to include to make it as realistic as possible.</p> 
<p>Animal poster Research an animal that is native to Africa. Can you make a poster all about it? Remember to include lots of different things such as facts about its appearance and diet .etc.</p> 	<p>Guess my shape Choose a 3D shape, and create your own 'Guess my shape' problem for your friends to solve. You will need to write clues about your shape by writing facts about how many faces it has etc. If you describe it well enough, they'll be sure to get it right!</p>  <p>3D shape like an ice cream cone. Flat face is a circle.</p>
