







Year 5 Home Learning: Term 2022

This half term, our topic will be 'All around the World'. We shall be focusing our learning around our core text, 'A Year Full of Stories'. We would like you to **complete at least two of the items listed in column 1** and then to choose **some, or all, of the tasks in column 2**. All written tasks can be submitted on Microsoft Teams, and practical tasks can be brought into school.

<p>Reading: Write a folk tale.</p> <p>As we are reading stories from around the world, choose a particular culture and explore their traditional tales. Write your favourite one in your own words and tell us why you enjoyed it.</p> 	<p>Writing: Persuade us</p> <p>You are a travel agent. Write a persuasive advertisement encouraging tourists to visit a country of your choice!</p> 
<p>Geography: Research</p> <p>Choose a biome and create a fact file about all the types of plants and animals found in that biome.</p> 	<p>Maths Poster</p> <p>Use your mathematical vocabulary to create a Maths poster about adding and subtracting fractions.</p> 
<p>Geography: Create</p> <p>Using your creativity, make a 3D model of a biome with a colour coded key.</p> 	<p>Science: Living things and their habitat</p> <p>Research and design a comparison model for the life cycle of two different animals, an amphibian and a mammal. Write the similarities and differences.</p>
