

Reading

This half term, the children will revisit all key reading skills. They will review how to predict, retrieve, infer and summarise. They will learn how to answer a range of comprehension questions. Children will also be given time each day to read for pleasure.

Writing

In writing, the children will be basing all of their extended pieces on the text 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin. They will produce biographies of the author, diary entries and end with writing a balanced argument.

Mathematics

This half term, the children will focus on written methods for multiplication and division will be the focus of our learning before will be exploring how to find equivalence, as well as order and compare fractions, decimals and percentages. We will continue to revise arithmetic and times table facts throughout the term.

Year Five

Spring 1 2023

Science

We will be studying 'Materials'. We will be comparing and grouping everyday materials based on evidence from fair tests including their hardness, solubility and thermal conductivity. Children will use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might separate, dissolve and evaporate, noting whether these changes of state are reversible.

History

In history, the children will learn about The Windrush: they will look at where people came from, why and how diversity has shaped Britain. The children will have the opportunity to explore images and music linked to the topic.

PSHE

In PSHE lessons this half term, we will be thinking about our dreams and goals. The children will be thinking about their aspirations and how they will achieve them. They will also take inspiration from Lewisham's Young Mayor.

PΕ

Year 5 will continue having dance on a Friday and Swimming/PE on a Tuesday. Children will need to come to school in their PE kits on Friday and bring their swimming/PE kits on Tuesday.

Dance

In dance, this term will be exploring force and friction through dance choreography. We will use transitions and dynamics to create exciting work linked closely to professional dance artist: Katie Prince.


Music

This half term, Year 5 are learning steel pans focusing on developing ensemble skills with an awareness of tempo, texture and dynamics.

French

In French this half term, we will be revisiting the topic of food! We will use the partitive (*du* etc) and consider (un)healthy choices; we shall also get to grips with recipe language.







Art

During art lessons, children will be learning about the botanical artwork of Beatrix Potter while exploring ink manipulation techniques and recording our findings in sketchbooks.

DT

We are learning about BAME Artists this term and celebrating with a Whole School Art Exhibition just before the end of this term. Year Five are learning about Mark Bradford through collage manipulation and texture exploration.

RE

In RE lessons this half term, children will learn about Islam. We will be understanding some of the ways Muslims show commitment to God.

Computing

In computing lessons this half term, the children will learn video filming and editing. They will have the opportunity to explore a brief history of moving images and video, before exploring different devices and apps, then eventually creating their own videos.
