







## Year 1 Home Learning: Spring 1

We would like you to complete at least **two of the items listed in column 1** and then to choose some or all of the tasks in column 2. All written tasks can be submitted on Microsoft Teams, and practical tasks can be photographed and uploaded to Teams or brought into school.

<p><b>Moon Must-haves!</b></p> <p>Year 1, you have been invited by Nasa to a once in a lifetime trip to the moon!! You are only allowed to take 5 objects. Which 5 objects will you take and why?</p> 	<p><b>Can you design your own alien?</b></p> <p>Can you design your own alien? Can you think of some powerful adjectives to describe your alien?</p> 
<p><b>Making 10s and 1s</b></p> <p>Have a go at partitioning 2 digit numbers. Roll the dice two times and make a 2 digit number. How many 10s and how many 1s in your 2 digit number? Remember the rule only 10 in a cup. You can use anything as counters for example dry beans, frozen peas, corn. Get partitioning.</p> 	<p><b>Solar System Diorama</b></p> <p>Have fun creating a solar system model. Why not scan the QR Code to listen to the 'Planets Song' as you make and do?</p> 
<p><b>Find out more about your favourite planet.</b></p> <p>Earth, Jupiter, Mars, Venus the list goes on. But which planet is your favourite planet? Can you research research your favourite planet? Why not have a go writing a fact about your favourite planet? Don't forget your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.</p> 	<p><b>Recyclable Rocket</b></p> <p>5, 4, 3, 2, 1 blast off!! Can you design a rocket? But here's the challenge, only use recyclable materials.</p>
