

Reading

The children will read 4 times per week either with an adult in the Resource Base or through guided reading sessions.

Children in Year 1 will attend guided reading sessions in their Year 1 classes which will be delivered in small groups 3 times per week.

We will be focusing on the accurate reading of words with 4 sounds e.g. wind.

Writing

This half term, we will be continuing to learn to write sentences independently using our phonics to support spelling. We will also begin to learn about when to use full stops in our writing.

Mathematics

We are going to revisit shapes. We will recap the basic 2D shapes and learn some of their properties.

We are also going to continue with addition and subtraction with some children learning how to add using partitioning and some children learning to count forwards and backwards on a number line.
