Reading

The children will read 4 times per week either with an adult in the Resource Base or through guided reading sessions.

Children in Year 1 will attend guided reading sessions in their Year 1 classes which will be delivered in small groups 3 times per week.

We will be focusing on the accurate reading of words with 4 sounds e.g. wind.

Writing

We will continue to encourage the children to write independently, focusing on their letter formation, finger spaces and full stops. The children always have the support of a word bank or a sentence formation board.

Mathematics

We are going to focus on subtraction and applying newly learned methods which we have practised for addition to subtraction calculations.

We will also continue consolidating our understanding of place value and the relationships between numbers.

Summer term 1 2024

Learning theme

This half term, we are going to be focusing on growing. Our growing topic will include growing plants, flowers and how we look after nature.

We will also be thinking about how humans grow and learning how to measure.

PSHE/ Life skills

We are going to be focusing on relationships including: who keeps us safe, what good friends are, what is kind and unkind and how to take turns and share.

We are also going to continue our life skills/ independence focus including: road safety when on school trips, exploring new foods and independent self-care.

Interventions:

- Language for thinking
- Talkabout - developing social skills
- Attention Autism
- Zones of Regulation
- Fine and gross motor skills development

Children will access the interventions outlined in their Education, Health and Care plan.

Music

The children will be using music technology to manipulate sounds and create soundscapes. They will compose their own pieces of music, giving consideration to the shape and sound of the different parts.



Art

In Art this term we will be exploring clay. We will learn about ways to make clay change shapes. We will make some pots to grow things in.

Dance

In dance this term we will be exploring dance from around the world using props. We will learn and develop rhythms, work with a Partners and create our own dances.
