## Reading

Children in EYFS will have daily phonics sessions learning rhyming songs to support early language development.

Children in Year 1 will have daily phonics sessions practising phase 3 sounds and building their independence with decoding unfamiliar words. They will also have reading sessions three times per week to further practise decoding.

If your child attends reading in their mainstream class, please refer to their year group bulletin.

#### **Mathematics**

We will be continuing with our number units and learning about numbers 1-5 (Reception children) including representing numbers in different ways, comparing values and showing 1 more/ less. Children in Year 1 will continue with addition using concrete objects to consolidate their understanding and then begin subtraction. Children in Year 2 will begin learning about multiplication and division including representing these concepts visually and solving simple word problems.

This will include: using cutlery, making healthy food, road safety and asking for help
