Mathematics



Science

Art

Year 5 are learning about Annie Leibovitz, the American photographer. We will be taking photographs and working on making accurate shades of grey to draw portraits.

DT

This half term, the children will consider what they can learn from the diets of different ethnically diverse cultures. They will be learning how to prepare vegetables correctly and use cutting tools safely.

RE
