



Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This term, we will continue to have regular circle times and story times when children can explore their feelings and consider the feelings of others. We also continue to help children to develop a positive sense of self by setting goals, encouraging them to try their best, to persevere and be resilient when facing a challenge. We will talk about their accomplishments

and encourage children to recognise their personal achievements.



Maths This term, we will be focusing on

numbers to 20 and beyond. Children will be able

to compare numbers within 20 and compare

quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognis-

ing when one quantity is greater than, less than

or the same as the other quantity. They will be

recalling number bonds up to at least 5, include

ing subtraction facts. Also, we will be exploring


and representing patterns within numbers, in-

cluding evens and odds, double facts and learn-

ing how quantities can be distributed equally.

The focus of this term is all about discovering and exploring the outside world. We will be using the stories 'First day at Bug School' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk' alongside this topic.




Communication & Language

This half term we will use story maps and story sequencing linked to the two focus books which enables the children to retell the story in role play opportunities. There will be lots of opportunities for the children to answer how and why questions.



We will be introducing lots of new vocabulary linked to minibeasts and plants.



Expressive Arts & Design

There will be lots of opportunities for children to observe plants and minibeasts to enable them to create their own artwork. The children will be learning how composers use dynamics to create music that is happy and sad, big and small. They will experiment with movements and use musical instruments which reflect the sounds made by different minibeasts. Reception will be visiting the Art Room and outdoor Creative Corner. They will be thinking about the power of looking! They will be contrasting observational drawing with drawing from imagination.

Literacy

We will be exploring minibeasts through the story 'First day at Bug School' and will be introducing information books linked to minibeasts and growing plants. Also, we will create a story map for the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. This term we will continue to develop sentence building and applying the chil-

dren's knowledge of all the GPC's learnt.



Physical Development

This term the children will develop their control over an object by pushing, patting, throwing and kicking. They will take part in group activities to develop those skills. They will also use different equipment such as beanbags, hoops, cones and balls to develop their gross motor skills. They will continue to develop fine motor skills exploring malleable materials and using a range of tools and utensils. They will continue to develop control and increased fluency when writing.

Our main focus this term is nature. The children will be looking at habitats and naming plants, birds and minibeasts. They will grow beans and butterflies and will ob+ serve the changes over time. The children will also learn about the importance of looking after the environment.
