Reading

During our whole class reading lessons, we will continue to focus on books linked to our topic. We will be developing our comprehension skills using VIPERS: vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and sequencing. Using these skills, we will then answer questions about what we have read in order to deepen our understanding and comprehension of the text.

Mathematics

This half term in Maths, we'll be exploring statistics by collecting and interpreting data using tally charts, block diagrams, and pictograms. We will also be focusing on position and direction as we learn to describe different movements and turns.

Science

In Science we will be continuing to learn all about plants. In addition we will learn all about the living things in our local area and observe and investigate a variety of habitats and micro-habitats, including the school grounds, our forest school area and the woodlands in Foster Park.

English

This half term we will be exploring incredible India! We will start off by making our very own invitations to a kite festival hosted by year 2. Dance


In dance this term we will explore the theme "Dance around the world". We will perform dances from Europe including Flamenco and Paso Doable and use props as a stimulus for choreography.

Music

Computing

This half term, we will learn how to create simple quizzes using ScratchJr by building sequences of code. We'll also learn how to improve our projects by testing, fixing, and making changes to our programs.







Art

Year 2 will continue building on some of the techniques learnt in the Art room during their clay module in Year 1. We will learn about using some tools other than our hands and focus on trying to make specific shapes. We will explore Khavda pottery-making from the Kutch region of Gujarat in India.

DT

In RE, we will be learning about peace. We'll explore what different religions teach about peace and learn about influential peace leaders, such as Martin Luther King Jr.
